- Level 3 Residential Childcare or Level 3 Diploma in Specialist Support for Teaching and Learning in Schools (D)

Experience:

- Knowledge of safeguarding and child protection including Keeping Children Safe in Education (Statutory Guidance) (D)

Skills:

- Demonstrates a working understanding of current theory and practice in relation to learning, care and support for young people who have special educational needs; (E)
- Demonstrates knowledge of the multidisciplinary needs of Valence students and how these can meet the individual needs of each student; (E)
- Must be physically fit to move and handle disabled children; (E)
