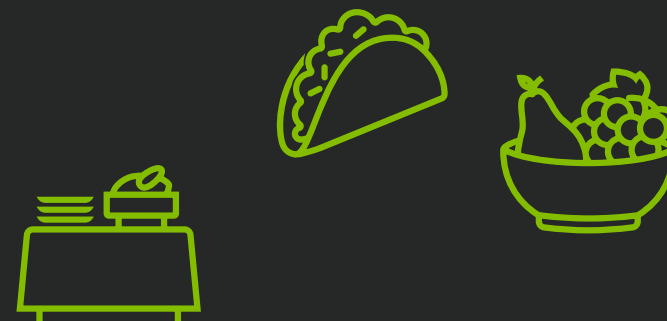

Responsible to:

Purpose of Job:

- To assist with serving daily school lunches
- To assist with catering for school functions, including in evenings

Specific responsibilities:

- To assist in serving school lunches to pupils and staff.
- To wash and dry kitchen utensils.
- To operate the commercial dishwasher and Utensil Wash.
- To clean kitchen floors and other areas, walls, store rooms etc.
- To assist in the preparation and storage of foodstuffs.
- To comply with all health and safety practices and food hygiene legislation.
- To assist with rubbish removal.
- To be familiar with cashless biometric systems.
- To provide front of house service.
- To be available to work school functions, including in evenings if required (overtime will be paid).
- To attend training as required.
- To assist with the deep clean which takes place over 2 days either side of the main school holidays.
- To perform any other jobs that may be commensurate with the post.

Health and Safety:

- To adhere to the School's waste policy.
- To understand and ensure the implementation of the School's Health & Safety and Safeguarding Policies.
- To report any faulty appliances, damaged equipment or any potential hazard.
- To promote safe working practices within the workplace.

General Responsibilities:

- To promote and safeguard the welfare of students you come into contact with.
- To promote and ensure the good reputation of the School.
- To be aware of and comply with all school policies and procedures, including the Staff Code of Conduct.
