- Plan, organise and prepare a variety of stimulating and age-appropriate activities.
- Supervise children during activities, snack times and transitions.
- Ensure the safety, welfare and wellbeing of all children attending the club.
- Promote positive behaviour in line with the school's Christian values and behaviour policy.
- Build positive relationships with children, parents, carers and colleagues.
- Maintain accurate attendance and collection records.
- Ensure the club environment is clean, safe and well organised.
- Follow safeguarding, health and safety and school policies at all times.
- Support children's social, emotional and personal development in a calm, caring and inclusive manner.
- Manage resources and equipment effectively to support the smooth running of the club.
