Breakfast Club Play Worker

Breakfast Club is an established and popular extended provision for our children and is located on the school premises. It provides a welcoming, stimulating, active environment where children can learn and develop while having fun.

Job Purpose

- To work as part of a team with the Club Supervisors.
- To support and assist the Club Supervisor in the development, organisation and day to day management of the club.
- To assist in the provision of a caring and secure environment for children to play, learn and relax.

Key Accountabilities

- To work as a member of the Breakfast Club team under the direction of the Supervisor, providing safe, creative and appropriate play opportunities including arranging equipment and preparing resources to support children's activities.
- To support the Supervisor in the planning and implementation of daily activities, ensuring that all the children's needs are met.
- To proactively support children and encourage them to interact with others.
- To have high expectations of children in terms of their behaviour, pre-empting and dealing with inappropriate behaviour in the context of the behaviour policy of the school and encouraging pupils to take responsibility for their own behaviour.
- To effectively communicate with children, colleagues and parents to maintain appropriate standards of behaviour
- Supervise children to ensure their health and safety and wellbeing at all times.
